Piedmont Housing Alliance (PHA) & the Charlottesville Community Design Center (CCDC) will be hosting a neighborhood planning & design workshop at the United Methodist Church on Crozet Avenue, Crozet on Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> between the hours of 4:00 PM and 7:00 PM to introduce the community to PHA and to solicit citizen input on the design of a new mixed-income neighborhood within a five minute walk from downtown Crozet. PHA and CCDC believe that the residents of Crozet are uniquely qualified to guide the planning and design process that will help the new neighborhood become a seamless extension of the historic village of Crozet. The information collected at this initial workshop will form the base for a second, more intensive, professionally facilitated collaborative design workshop that will be held in June. PHA & CCDC encourage Crozet residents of all ages to please try to attend at least some part of this initial workshop to express your concerns AND ideas to the workshop facilitators, so that PHA can better prepare for the next phase of the design process.
